Eligibility Criteria

- Registered and authorize to operate as constructor in Balochistan and Punjab, Pakistan
- Registered with Pakistan Engineering Council as constructor
- The constructor is an active tax payer as per FBR
- Having minimum 5 years' proven track of previous experience in construction of same infrastructures fall under public/commercial/NGOs categories
- Previous experience of construction in the project location will be preferred
- Understanding to systems of RAHMA/NGOs will be an asset but not necessary

Payment Terms
