750 destitute families received Ramadan Food Packages with support from Charity For Life



support from Charity For Life, Rahma Islamic Relief distributed 750 food packages among the most deserving and the needy families in Khuiratta, Gulpur and Neelum Valley (Azad Kashmir) and Tharpakar (Sindh) Pakistan. Each Food package was containing approved quantities of Flour, Cooking Oil, Pulses, Rice, Basin, Dates, Sugar, Salt, Chilli powder, Tea and Soaps.

During whole process of the distribution, SOPs for corona virus were strictly complied with. Each

place was provided with seating arrangement where it could be possible. Drinking water was available at each point and every one was dealt with respect ensuring dignity. The elderly, the women or handicapped who were

not able to approach the distribution points were delivered packages to their doorstep. The activity was appreciated widely and the feedback of communities at each location was overwhelming.

ollectively, 11501 people benefitted through different services as OPD, medical tests, maternity as well as ambulance services etc. Though in the quarter we could not do much regarding community level outreach activities due to third wave of Covid-19. However we successfully arranged a free medical camp for the general patients at RAHMA Hospital Janpur, Rahim Yar Khan in a well-controlled environment following SOPs for the prevailing virus. On the other hand, a screening camp was also organized for hepatitis B and C at higher secondary school/college Seri, Khuiratta, Kotli Azad Kashmir.







Supplementing the efforts of government towards Polio Free Pakistan

s usual, RAHMA kept assisting the government towards achieving the goal of Polio Free Pakistan. Polio campaign 2021 continued from March 29 to April 2, 2021 at RAHMA Hospital Janpur Rahim Yar Khan. In the result of awareness raising by the staff at communities, a large number of people kept visiting the hospital during campaign days to get their children vaccinated against polio.

fter a major gap due to prevalent pandemic, regular classes had been conducted adhering SOPs until March 15, 2021 when once again schools were ordered to be closed. During regular classes, students were provided with masks and sanitizers while classrooms were regularly sprayed to ensure health safety of students and the staff. Final examinations were conducted during this period followed by sharing of results with the parents on Annual Day.

All school staff participated in a training session on child protection organized by RIR head office. Furthermore, UNICEF PAHCHAAN also conducted a session at school on child abuse, self-defense and psychological counselling to manage Covid -19 crisis.

Officials from health department visited with regards to typhoid vaccination campaign and students having consent of their parents got vaccination.

After closure of the school, staff remained regular and functioning and they completed different tasks including one for preparation and finalization of syllabus for the session 2021/22. Despite Covid crisis, in the result of an efficient enrollment campaign run by the school staff, nine new students have been enrolled in these three months.









1661 individuals got access to safe water in Tharparkar, Sindh

AHMA Islamic Relief has been endeavoring since inception to make safe drinking water accessible to the marginalized communities with financial support from different individual and organizational donors.

Installation of thirteen hand pumps has been completed during the quarter in three Talukas of district Tharparkar increasing access of 348 families (1661 individuals) to safe drinking water.

4,000 households got access to safe drinking water through installation of water filtration plants in Rahim Yar Khan, Punjab

nstallation of five RO water filtration plants completed in February 2021 with financial support from RIRF. All these plants have now started benefitting 4,000 households in five Union Councils (UCs) of Tehsil Liaqatpur, district Rahim Yar Khan. Generally the whole population in these UCs and particularly those reside closer to these plants are getting benefit on daily basis including the nearby shopkeepers, laborers as well as the people passing through these areas. Beneficiaries and local community is very happy and all are determined to take care of these plants so that these should sustain for longer period of time.
